How is the course assessed?

- Complete a series of challenges to demonstrate skills,
 knowledge and understanding across six units
- Complete recording documents
- Present an organised portfolio of evidence
- No formal examination.



Course Structure

- Split into six units
 - Introduction to Working with Others
 - Introduction to Improving own Learning and Performance
 - Introduction to Problem Solving
 - Planning and Carrying out a Piece of Research
 - Communication through Discussion
 - Planning and Giving an Oral Presentation

How can you support?

 Speak to your child on a regular basis about what they have learnt and encourage them to come and speak to their teacher if they are unsure of anything.
