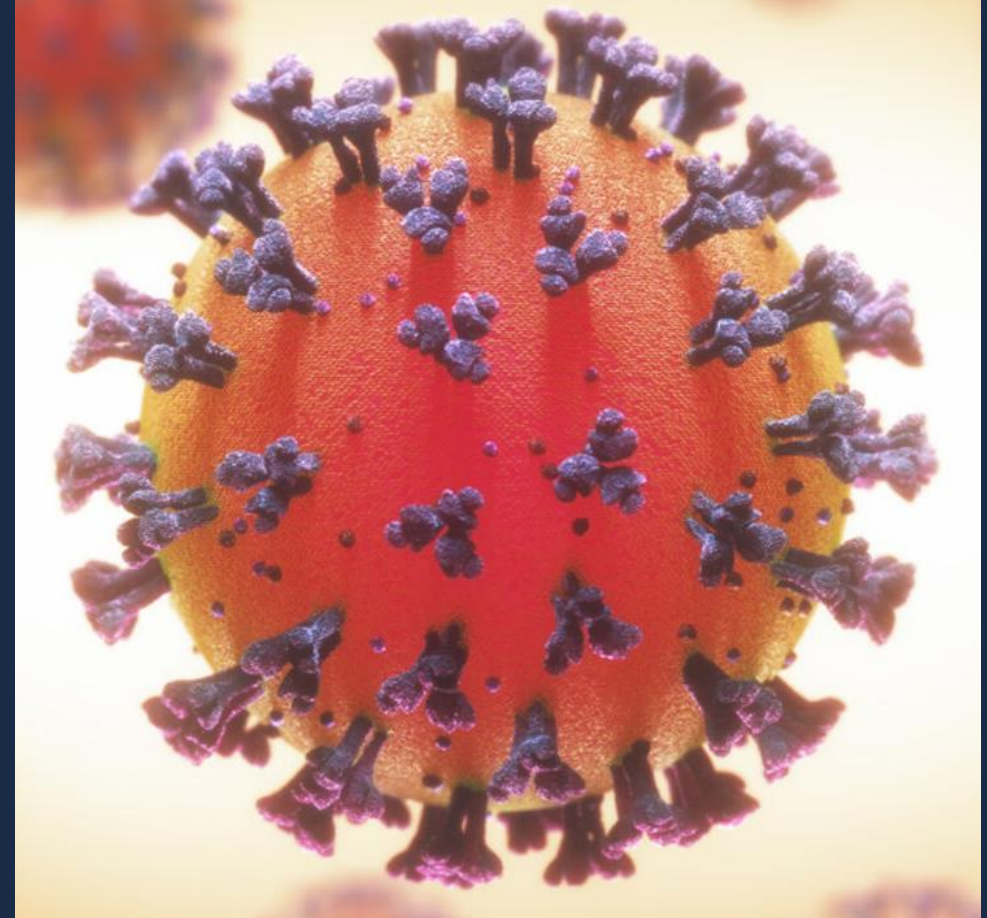

# How can you reduce your risk?

- Try to stay at least 2 metres (3 steps) away from anyone you do not live with or anyone not in your bubble
- Wear a face mask that covers your nose and mouth when it's hard to stay away from other people

# How can you reduce your risk?

- Wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze and put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
- Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean

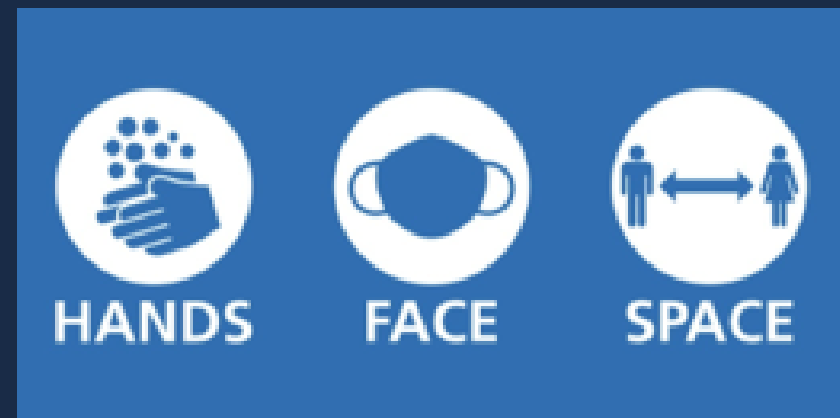

# The Misbourne Face Mask Guidance

For your safety and protection, we are advising that students and staff wear their face mask in all indoor, communal areas.

## These include:

- all corridors, regardless of the time of day
- the Café, when not eating and drinking
- the marquee
- when in detention
- going to the toilet



## You **DO NOT** have to wear your face mask:

- outside. You will be asked to put your face mask on when in your line ups
- when in lessons

# What are 'bubbles' and why do we have them?

- A 'bubble' is defined as a group of people who can mix together
- Bubbles allow some people more contact with others, while keeping other social distancing measures in place.
- We have year group bubbles, therefore you are in a bubble with the other students in your year group. You should still socially distance within your bubble where possible.
- It is important that you don't mix with students outside of your year group bubble
