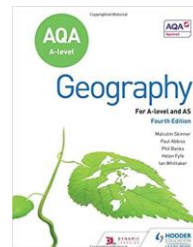

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Bridging Work (to be submitted in your first lesson in September)

Activity 1

You are to investigate a specific TNC (Transnational Corporation)

Produce a report on your TNC and have it ready to send it to me on our return to school in September. It is up to you how you present it PowerPoint, mind map, or a report.

You need to:

1. Define what a TNC is
2. Where is their HQ
3. Produce a chronology of the company.
4. What do they sell (all produces)?
5. How many people do they employ?
6. What countries to they operate in?
7. How much profit do they make?
8. What complaints have people against them?
9. Any other information.

You also need to have a bibliography at the end of your presentation.

You should try and use a range of source (text, dvd, internet and journals).

Activity 2

Cyclone Amphan – Cyclone Amphan has recently struck India and Bangladesh, your task is to research - the following:

- Location
- Background information – why does this area suffer from cyclones, how often are they, what damage have they caused in the past?
- Causes
- Timeline
- Impacts (primary and secondary)

- Responses (pre event, immediate and long term).
- Summarise how Covid-19 has impacted the ability to respond to the event.
