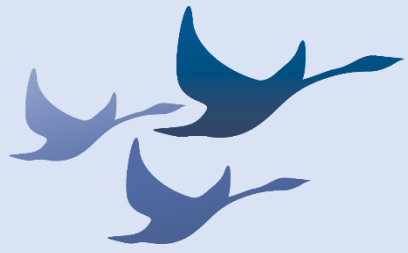

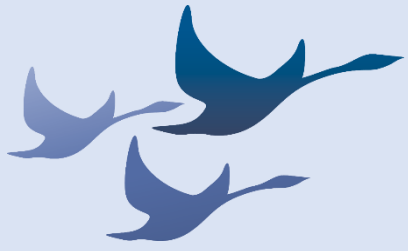
# Welcome to GCSE Spanish

- AQA
- 100% exam
- 4 papers, each worth 25%:
  - Paper 1: Listening (25%) 35 mins (f) 45 mins (h)
  - Paper 2: Speaking (25%) 7-9 mins (f) 10-12 mins (h)
  - Paper 3: Reading & translation (25%) 45 mins (f) 60 mins (h)
  - Paper 4: Writing & translation (25%) 60 mins (f) 75 mins (h)



# Our expectations

- Students must attend as many lessons as possible, **high attendance is vital**
- **Have the right equipment** – your book, pens, usernames & passwords for Kerboodle and the right attitude!
- Any missed work must be caught up on – **it is the responsibility of students to find their teacher to discuss**
- **Vocab test and revision homework** – sufficient time dedicated to this



# How we support our students:

- We provide clarity:
  - At the beginning of every unit we give students unit overviews with language focus.
  - Clear objectives
  - We assess our students consistently at the end of every unit
- We provide them with direction and guidance
  - We share their targets with them and plan a path to success with them.

# Taking responsibility

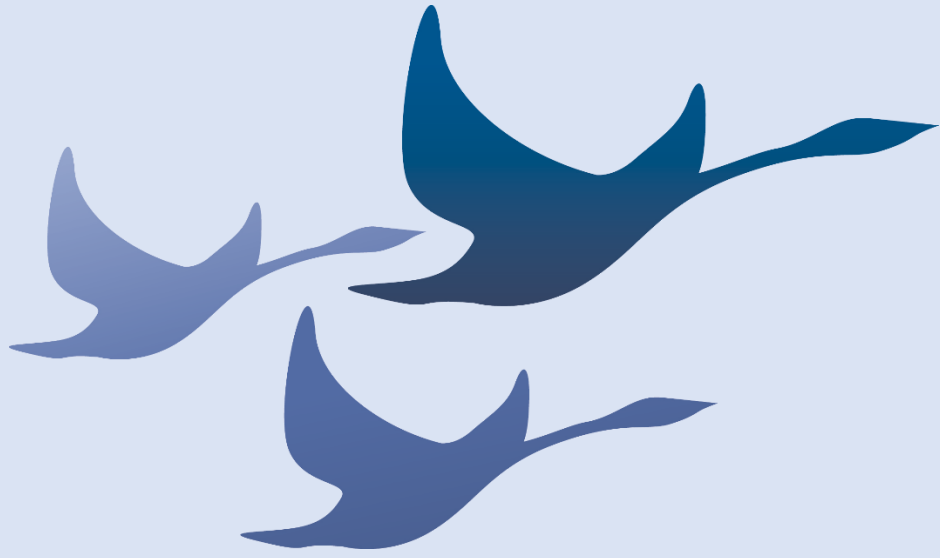
*Students should:*
