

Sixth Form Dress Code from Sept 2020

At The Misbourne, we are extremely proud of our Sixth Form, who dress smartly as part of their approach to taking their studies seriously in an 11-18 school setting. They act as role models to the whole school and are regularly commended for their appearance. They gain confidence and self-esteem which is taken forward into work experience and interviews for university and employment. We also believe that our students deserve a chance to express their individuality. Our 'business dress policy' was devised by students and staff and is to be followed at all times except non-uniform days, which are scheduled at regular intervals. Students are to follow either route A or B.

Permitted items:

- Plain jumper / cardigan
- One set of small stud or hoop earrings
- The wearing of one modest nose stud
- Smart outdoor coat (which must not be worn inside)
- Modest makeup and nail varnish

Not permitted:

- Trainers
- Hoodies
- Vest tops
- Shorts
- Revealing clothing or strappy tops
- Torn / ripped / frayed clothing
- Impractical or dangerous footwear
- Sweatshirts / T-shirts
- Bright hair colours – only natural hair colours are permitted.
- Logos shaved into hair
- Leggings / jeggings or tracksuits
- Jeans
- Caps/Hats

Etiquette as a Sixth Form role model:

- Headphones and phones are to only be used in the study room/areas and not around the school site
- Undergarments are not to be seen
- Coats, sunglasses and scarves are not to be worn inside
- Tattoos must not be visible
- Eating is only to take place in permitted areas

Praise includes Achievement Points and chances to win raffle prizes. **Sanctions** follow a warning and the opportunity to correct the issue as soon as possible. Persistent incidents

may result in a student being sent home to change or isolated from other students/lessons in line with the whole school behaviour policy.
