A reminder that, with the Government's relaxation of social distancing regulations, our students are able to use the PE changing rooms again. Therefore, students should no longer wear their PE kits to school on the days that they have PE but should arrive at school in their school uniform and bring their PE kit with them in the usual way to get changed at the start of their PE lesson.

Covid-19 information

Lateral Flow Tests (LFTs)

Following our students' LFTs in school prior to their return this term, the Government is asking all secondary school students to conduct an LFT at home twice weekly. All students have been supplied with a pack of test kits for this purpose. These tests ought to be spaced at least three days apart each week, such as every Wednesday and Sunday. Students should upload their results on to www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result. Please notify the school immediately via covid@themisbourne.co.uk if your child receives a positive test result.
