Covid vaccinations for 12-15 year olds

There has been much speculation over recent days and weeks as to whether or not children aged 12-15 would be offered a Covid-19 vaccination. As of yesterday, we received notification from the Buckinghamshire Immunisation Team that these will now take place on school sites and will be commencing from next week.

The date that has been allocated to our school is **Wednesday 20 October 2021**.

Whilst I am sure that many of you will welcome this news, some of you will still have questions, which is understandable. However, as far as the responsibility of the school is concerned, we are only providing the space for vaccinations to take place and are not in a position to be able to offer advice. Vaccinations will be run through the usual Bucks Immunisation team; please direct any questions you may have to them or the local public health team.

I have been advised that a letter for families and a consent form will be coming from the immunisation team, but I am yet to receive this. As soon as we have it, we will send it to all families and will, of course, keep you updated with any additional information we may receive.
