Dear Families,

It is hoped that in May half term 2021 we will be able to run a Sports Tour to Salou, Spain. This is something we usually do biannually but was cancelled last year due to Covid-19.

The tour will be to play girls' netball and boys' football and will be open to all Year 8, 9 and 10 students, regardless of ability. In addition to the football and netball matches, the Tour will also include a trip to the Camp Nou Stadium – home of FC Barcelona, shopping in Barcelona and a day at a local waterpark.

Due to current Department for Education restrictions on overnight stays for schools, we are unable to book as the insurance company will not cover us for Covid-19-related cancellation. However, I am writing to you to make you aware that this is a trip that we very much hope we will be able to offer so, if your child would like to be considered for the trip, it may be prudent to start saving now. We will book as soon as we know the insurance is in place but the turnaround could be quite tight!

It is envisaged the trip will cost approximately £910, which is only £5 more than last year. Obviously this could change depending on when we book and flight availability.

For those parents that had a refund from last year's cancelled Tour and asked the school to retain the funds for next year's trip, this money is safe. Of course, if at any time you decide you would like it returned, please do get in touch.

I will write again when I am able to confirm that the trip can go ahead.
