Re: Year 11 – next steps guidance, and preparation for Sixth Form

In a normal school year, aside from preparing students for exams, one of the most important things we would be doing at this time would be talking to all of our Year 11s to check they are happy with their planned next steps and, if they have applied, their Sixth Form subject choices.

Despite the school closure and current situation, we think this is more important than ever to undertake fully and personally.

During the three weeks beginning 4th May we will be scheduling a phone call to every Year 11 student. The calls will last for up to ten minutes.

The purpose of the call will be to:

1. Discuss with the student their planned route for September and offer any further support or guidance.
2. For students that have applied to The Misbourne Sixth Form, to check whether their subject choices work with the school timetable's option blocks for September and to offer any further support or guidance.

Over the next couple of weeks, we will be compiling preparation for Sixth Form activities for all our A-level and equivalent subjects. When these are ready and posted on the school website, we will notify all applicants via email. All students will be required to complete the preparation activities for their courses and to bring these to their first lessons in September.

Please look out for an email next week with your call time and respond to the email if it is not convenient. We recommend that a parent is available at the same time of the call to listen in on loud speaker.
