As part of our on-going curriculum enrichment provision in school, we are running a series of Enrichment Days each year, to provide students with the opportunity to bring learning to life and experience aspects of the curriculum that they may not usually have the chance to.

We are pleased to let you know that the first of these Enrichment Days will be on Monday 30th March 2020. All our students will be in their year groups for the day, experiencing a range of exciting activities/events led by different curriculum areas:

- Who is the event for? Year 7 Students
- Which Curriculum areas will be running the day? English and Art departments
- What does the day involve? Year 7 will have a day centred around the world of Journalism, learning how the media can control what we read, see and hear. They will become journalists, copy editors, graphic designers, sports reporters, live correspondents and photo journalists. Working in their classes, (as part of a House Competition), to produce several items of news, students will produce elements of news and learn the different aspects of reporting including: designing a new logo and name for a newspaper, becoming a photographer to take photos of a pretend crime scene, creating and editing a passionate opinion article or writing and performing live newscast. They will be also be joined during the day by an actual volunteer news professional who will guide and offer advice, giving an insight into the world of news.
